1. Welcome from Chairman
2. Apologies and reasons heard and proposed to accept from Cllr John Wood, also apologies heard from Lincolnshire County Councillor Tom Ashton.
3. No declarations of interest at this point.
4. Proposal to accept the notes previously circulated as a true and correct record of the meeting held May 2021, Cllr Daft, seconded Cllr Standage, all voted in favour RESOLVED – minutes signed and dated by Chairman.
5. Councillor Jones read out a report from the County Cllr Tom Ashton; an overall under spend of £10 million over 2020 is to be spent on helping to repair roads. ELD Cllr Neil Jones reported that the East Lindsey, Boston Borough merger has gone well they will be joining forces with South Holland in the near future hopefully this will again save money by combining services across the three areas.
6. Antons Gowt parking on the roadside is causing damage to the verges; there are a few groups which now use this popular stretch of the River Witham for activities; there is just nowhere to park; Lincolnshire Highways have been contacted and Clerk will continue to seek advice from them.
7. Langrick Village Hall – Proposal to seed the grassed area after treatment for weeds and importation of some topsoil to bring up the levels, seconded all voted in favour to get this done this autumn to allow for a good cover for spring 2022. RESOLVED Proposal to purchase outdoor tables and seating for the gardens, Cllr Cooper, seconded Cllr Cawthorn, all voted in favour RESOLVED. Clerk to action purchase.
8. Platinum Jubilee June 2022 it was Proposed Cllr Daft to ear mark £1000 for the celebration details of which are to be confirmed, Cllr Cooper seconded all voted in favour RESOLVED.
9. Finances – Chairman Cllr Jones proposed the payments as listed be paid, seconded Cllr Standage; all in favour RESOLVED. Clerks salary June/July £312, HMRC £78, grass cutting £80, replacement electrodes for defibrillator £23.48, signage for phone boxes de-fibs £76.80, installation de-fib cabinets x 3 £225, electricity hall £25.27, village marker/gates x 4 £300. Car park work incomplete invoice to follow, resolution to pay on completion.
