- 5.12 **Reports District and County Council** Cllr Jones in his capacity as ELDistrict Cllr reported on the introduction of the recycling changes all households are to get a purple bin to take paper and card only this separation from the cans and other recycling goods, should massively improve the amount of useable paper and card, this has been trialled in North Kesteven and is proving to be beneficial.
