51. Chairman Neil Jones welcomed all to the meeting, wishing everyone a Happy New Year.

1. Land off Gipsy Drove – S/096/01810/10 breach of planning; order issued for Caravan to be removed from site, time limit allowed 2 months.

1. Concessionary Travel Scheme, Bus Passes the distribution of these is moving from the District Council to the County Council, from 1st April 2011 all applications for new bus passes will have to be made through Lincolnshire County Council.
2. Mobile Library – no persons visited the Langrick stop during the 3 month monitoring period, this stop will be discontinued after 31st March 2011.
3. Community Buildings – Lottery funding is available to improve community halls/ church halls enable them to offer a wide variety of activities over a broad group base.
